Michael Thompson is the Associate Conductor and Principal Trumpet of the Symphony Orchestra of Northern Virginia. Michael joined SONOVA during its first season and is excited to be conducting his first full concert with the orchestra this evening.

Michael attended Grammy Award-winning South Salem High School in Salem, Oregon where he was a member of the Wind Ensemble, Full Orchestra, and Jazz Band and, as a senior, was the recipient of the John Philip Sousa and Louis Armstrong awards. Michael studied trumpet performance and music at the University of Oregon and was the trumpet section leader of the Oregon Symphonic Band and the Oregon Athletic Bands, as well as the Musical Director of the Green Garter Band. As a trumpeter, Michael has played in productions of A Roadkill Opera, Les Misérables, Into the Woods, and The Music Man and has performed in the Sydney Opera House and across the United States. Michael has recorded with the Oregon Marching Band, Green Garter Band, St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Salem, Oregon, and the original cast recording of A Roadkill Opera and can be also be found on numerous live recordings and in the introduction to EA Sport's NCAA March Madness 2004.
